Dr. Steve Biemer

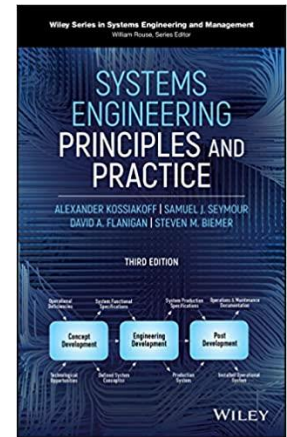
